Project “nIcyp4kids” (nIc violence prevention education for kids) is an after hours integrated character education program for Shawano community children in grades 1 – 4. A shuttle bus will be available at the Lincoln School for students coming from that area. Transportation will not be provided after the program. Parents/caregivers are expected to pick up their child/children at 5:00 p.m.

PLEASE CHOOSE TWO OF THE CLASS OFFERINGS:

Storytelling: Learn to use your facial expressions; your body language; and unique props to tell a really good story. In Storytelling, you will be an important part of telling a class story and have the opportunity to tell one of many short stories. You will capture your audience’s attention as you dramatically recreate a story!

Exploring Art: You will experience color, texture, and design as you explore art through a variety of mediums. In this class, you will be able to express yourself by conveying your ideas on paper. Your final pieces of artwork will be on display for viewing by family members, friends, and the community during the last session of class.

Spanish for Kids: Learning a second language is easy, fun, and entertaining! We play games, sing songs, and watch videos. Through these activities you will learn Spanish. Before you know it, you will know in Spanish numbers, body parts, days of the week, months of the year, colors, animals, daily activities, and much, much, more!

Recorder Choir: Learn to play and perform music in the Recorder Choir! As part of the Recorder Choir, you will be actively involved in a team learning experience. Take note: You will have the opportunity to experience rhythm through movement; learn about notes and rests; write short musical responses; play both melody and accompaniment parts; create ostinato patterns; and swing to a little improvisation. Come and make beautiful music!

Let’s Learn About the Environment: Using math and science together, we will study and explore the outside world around us. In this class, you will be looking at the environment through a new set of eyes as you observe, compare, analyze, and interpret information. Come for the fun and the learning!

Country Dance for Kids: Have fun learning the basic steps and patterns in country dancing. This is your chance to experience movement and dance through traditional country dancing routines. Wear your western hat and boots and come on out and dance!

Creative Writing: While enhancing your skills of observation and interpretation, you will write and illustrate short descriptive responses in a writing journal. Photographs, assorted pieces of artwork, and interesting objects will serve as the basis for your creative writing ideas. Imagine having one hundred ideas to write about!

Healthy Me: Everyone wants to be healthy! In this class, you will be introduced to a variety of ways that kids can learn to lead a healthy life style. Topics covered; nutritional snacks; relaxation techniques through stretching, bending, balancing, and breathing; use jumping rope as a stress reducer and behavior control method;;and how the human body functions as a wonderful working machine. Bring along your jump rope and a yoga mat or a large bath towel.
